Dear Parents

1. We have been invited to participate in a number of **Community Service projects** over the next few weeks. Please encourage your child to support these initiatives.

- 1.1 **CIVVIES DAY**

- A "civvies day" will be held on **Friday 20 May** in aid of Msunduzi Hospice. The cost per person is R5-00.

- 1.2 **"FOOTLOOSE"**

- This is arranged by "Youth of Choice" with the aim of making people aware of those less fortunate than ourselves who do not have shoes to wear. On Wednesday 1 June EVERYONE at school will be asked to remove their shoes and socks and go barefoot for a while, to experience what it is like to go without shoes in winter.

- Please send any old (reusable) shoes to school to donate to this project. The donated shoes will be distributed amongst needy households.

- 1.3 **CHILD HEADED HOUSEHOLDS SERVICE PROJECT**

- The Girl Guides Association, of which some of our learners are members, are asking for donations of foodstuff with extended shelf-life, clothing and books which will be given to needy child-headed households.

2. **FUN DAY**

- This will be held on Saturday 21 May 2011 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. This is a COMPULSORY school day, and as such, all learners are expected to attend. We would like the whole family to accompany the learners and to join in with the fun. There will be food on sale and a number of activities for everyone in the family to get involved in. You are welcome to bring along a picnic "tea" to enjoy with your family and friends.
